## LABEL INFORMATION

### DIRECTIONS: Maintenance, Spray

**Gun and Hose:** It is recommended to flush the hose and gun between each new cylinder of Golden Bear Adhesive Remover. This will insure a fresh start with your new adhesive cylinder and increase the life of your hose and spray gun. Shut off cylinder valve on used adhesive cylinder and bleed the pressure from the hose by spraying the gun into a disposable container. Remove hose from adhesive cylinder and attach to cylinder. Open adhesive valve and spray.

### Clogged Hose and Spray Gun:

Shut off cylinder valve on used adhesive cylinder and bleed the pressure from the hose by spraying the gun into a disposable container. Remove hose from adhesive cylinder and attach to cylinder. Open valve. Let system sit for 5 minutes. Stay gun into a disposable container. Repeat until clean. Shut off cylinder valve and bleed pressure from hose by spraying the gun. Remove hose from cylinder and put back on adhesive cylinder. Open adhesive valve and spray.

### Clean Up Excess Adhesive:

With hose and spray gun attached, spray directly onto adhesive to be removed and wipe with cloth. For more control, spray directly on to cloth and then wipe away adhesive. Always wear rubber gloves and safety goggles. Wash hands after use.

### DANGERS: Read and understand the product's label and Safety Data Sheet.

## CONTAINS

## First Aid Measures

## Precautions

## Storage

**Keep out of reach of children.** Lock up and store in a cool, dry area. Keep containers tightly closed. Follow label directions.

## In Case of Fire

Use dry chemical, carbon dioxide and foam to extinguish fire. Wear NIOSH approved Self Contained Breathing Apparatus with a full face piece operated in a positive pressure demand mode with full body protective clothing when fighting fires.
